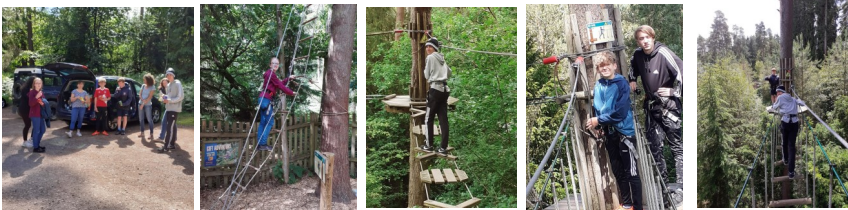
Would you prefer to make sandwiches etc instead of working alongside the children?

Sam Sharpe was hanged in Montego Bay on 23 May, 1832 after initiating and leading a revolt for justice. Just before his execution he said: 'I would rather die upon yonder gallows, than live in slavery.' The revolt and Sharpe's actions played a huge role in British parliamentary deliberations, and ultimately the Slavery Abolition Act in 1833. It is this legacy the Sam Sharpe Project seeks to build upon by promoting his story and exploring his relevance in today's context.
